### CHURCHWIDE CASWELL RETREAT

We hope your family is making plans to join us for the weekend of April 5-7, for our annual Churchwide Retreat at Caswell! We'll have all the elements of retreat including individual prayer time, recreation, Bible study, crafts, worship, and community meals, all with an intergenerational focus. Though we encourage entire families to participate, 3rd-12th graders are welcome to come even if parents are unable to attend. A few private rooms are still available (though filling up fast!) in addition to single-gendered bunk rooms!

The cost is \$70/person for the weekend **with a family max of \$200**. This includes lodging for two nights, meals, and supplies for the retreat. If your family would rather make your own arrangements to sleep off-campus in a near-by hotel and commute in for the retreat, the cost is \$25/person to cover food and supplies. Checks can be turned in to the church office, or payment can be made by one of the following other methods: Church Kiosk, Vanco On-Line, Give + Mobile, Give + On-Line, and Paypal. 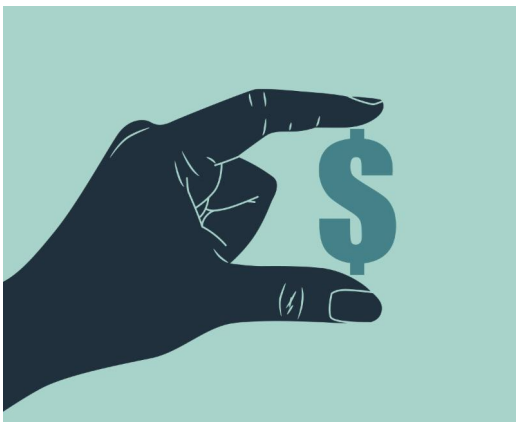
