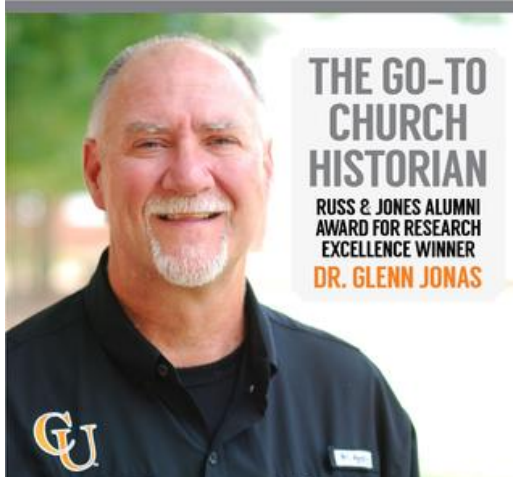

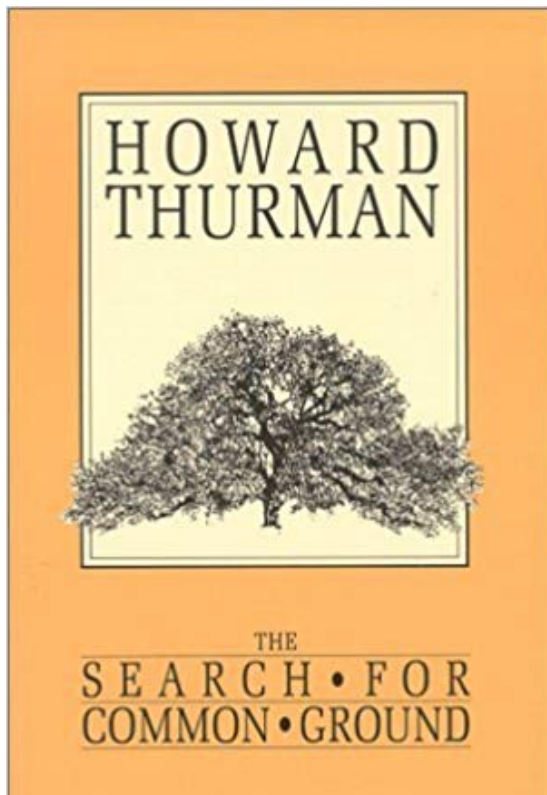

MAY MISSION PROJECT

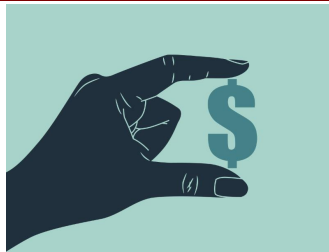
