#### MINUTES OF THE CHURCH CONFERENCE OF THE

#### **DECEMBER 15, 2021**

#### Call to Order

Matt Bullard brought the December 15th 2021 conference to order at 6:17pm.

#### **Business**

The November 17<sup>th</sup> minutes were approved. Church membership was 1329 at that conference. Shirley English died on November 22<sup>nd</sup>. On November 21<sup>st</sup> Richard Wood and Beth Cockman-Wood joined by transfer of letter and Megan Wood joined by profession of faith. Our membership is now 1331.

#### **Standing Committee Reports**

Dream Team: Chair-person Mary Nash Rusher gave a report. We've been working all fall. Our first exercise was about our meaningful experiences at First Baptist and what we would like to pull into the present and future. We've talked with outside folks to see how we can be church in this place. Last Wednesday's exercise was to think about what we have—what are our assets. We put our assets on separate pieces of paper. Then we thought about what we could do with those assets that we're not already doing. The Dream Team will be synthesizing everything we've done this fall.

Properties Committee: Holly Ivel gave the report. She thanked Derek Foster for leading the committee this year. There are some leaking pipes in the Clothing Ministry area. An examination determined that it's coming from the steam venting pipes going up to the sanctuary. All the pipes have degraded and cannot be fixed. We're going to install a condensation system that will bypass those pipes. It's going to cost \$92,600 to make the repairs and will take up some space in the Clothing Ministry. We're still waiting on playground equipment parts and an audio equipment estimate. Some wrought iron fencing on the front steps was repaired. The committee met with IQ Contracting and structural engineer Chuck Lysaght in November regarding the repairs on the front steps. Written plans are expected soon. Also expected soon is an updated assessment and in January an updated estimate. A chiller relay board was replaced for \$2,328.50. We are going to look at the vans we're currently using to see if they are at a higher risk for rollover.

Nominating Committee: Chair Margaret Barham presented the nominees. She gave thanks the committee—Wyatt Yelverton, Susan Sanford, Nancye Gaj, Clint Neal, Delores Bailey, Allison Strickland, Laura Rohrbaugh, Randy Tucker, and Bob Talley – for their work and meeting remotely. The committee will work on Sunday School positions in January. We have a real crisis getting Sunday School teachers; primarily in children's area, including preschool. It's very difficult to get people to commit for a full year to an every-Sunday job. We may need to look at what Sunday School will need to look like. It took five months to fill five slots. #### All were approved.

Finance Committee: Chair Matt Strickland gave the report. November revenue was \$165,466.48 and expenses were \$106,995.78 for a net (surplus) of \$58,470.70. Really good news. And things are also looking good in December. Year-to-date revenue is \$1,217,132.32 and expenses are \$1,206,316.81, for a surplus of \$10,815.51. This combined with the carryover of \$139,719.96 gives us a year-to-date surplus of \$150,535.47. So we're ending the year strong—thanks to the congregation.

For the FY2022 Stewardship Campaign, as of 12/9 we have 137 pledges totaling \$927,173.00. Last year on 12/10/2021 we had 146 pledges totaling \$1,036,361.00. We are behind 2021 Stewardship, but we also started a week later. We like to get to 80% of the contributed revenue budget line item pledged, which is \$1,196,774.40 (80% of \$1,495,968). We are currently at 62% or \$269,610.40 short.

Two requests came from the properties committee. \$2,497.31 to fix a faulty chiller relay board. The other was \$92,000 to repair one half of the sanctuary steam heating system, replacing it with a condensation tank. Both were approved by the finance committee. These expenses come out the Capital Repair and Replacement Fund. Conference approved the \$92,000 repair.

Matt thanked the church and the finance committee. Special thanks to Beth Jones, Chuck Nichols, Rhonda Lowe, and Brad Wilson who have served for the last three years and will be rolling off the committee. Thanks also to Art Jackson, Brenda Mullins, Laura Archer, John Baldwin, and Ann Rollins for their continued service.

Personnel Committee: Presented by chair Daniel Rohrbaugh.

#### Closing

Chris Chapman mentioned what a wonderful year it had been: adding staff, the Dream Team process, an incredible Toy Joy, and an in-person Hanging of the Greens. The congregation has been incredibly generous and supportive. We will probably continue hybrid in some areas. Thanks to Matt Bullard for his leadership this year.

The description of the Properties Committee in the church bylaws outlines its role relative to budgeting, rules, policies and maintenance of the building and other church property. Additionally, the committee works closely with the Church Administrator who is responsible for supervision of facility staff and outside contracts that provide necessary maintenance and repairs for FBC property.

Our church building is a very large and active place. Multiple groups, both from within the church and community groups, use our building every week in addition to the wide variety of special events that occur over the entire year. The ministers are key leaders and participants in these activities as well as the many other church members who also lead and attend. It is into

this context of building use, need and church activity that the Properties Committee role is implemented.

Individuals who are best able to successfully fill the roles of Property Committee members are

those who are actively involved in the life of the church such that they fully understand the needs and issues associated with the many uses of our building. Expertise in an area related to property repair and maintenance can be an added benefit but is not the primary asset or requirement of a committee member.

Our church administrator and contractors provide the information that is needed to enable committee members to make decisions regarding maintenance and repair of the building. There is also discussion within the committee and opportunities for members to ask questions, get additional information and evaluate issues before making the decisions necessary for the successful care of our church.

The trustees meet at least semi-annually and at such times as necessary to carry out their duties. Action by a majority of the trustees is sufficient to bind the church. The trustees have the following duties:

- 1. Represent the church in its legal and property matters.
- 2. Execute all deeds, mortgages, or other instruments that involve the acquisition or transfer of property when authorized to do so by the church.
- 3. Execute all contracts valued at \$10,000.00 or more when authorized to do so by the church. All contracts for expenditures under \$10,000.00 budgeted and authorized by the Finance Committee or the church may be executed by the pastor or his or her designee.
- 4. Monitor the church's compliance with legal requirements in all contracts, deeds, mortgages, trusts, bequests, or other instruments affecting the church.
- 5. Keep a written record of their activities on behalf of the church.
- 6. Develop policies regarding designated and undesignated gifts and bequests and implementing language for those policies for the operations manual.
- 7. Conduct an annual review of the constitution and bylaws and recommend amendments to the church as needed. Review any amendments to the constitution or bylaws that are proposed by any other person or organization in the church and submit recommendations concerning such amendments to the church.
- 8. Submit a report to the first regular church conference following the year of service that summarizes any legal and property activities or matters of interest to the church. The report and the written record of the trustees' activities are made a part of the minutes of the church conference.
