**Mission Project...** for our mission offering, we will be collecting new packages of children's undies (all sizes) for children of participants at Caring Connections, a mentoring program for women in the greater Raleigh area who feel overwhelmed and alone as they face barriers of poverty, substance misuse recovery, re-entry after justice involvement, or underemployment. Their mission is to equip participants with essential skills that lead to self-sufficiency through a personal mentoring relationship that provides support, hope, and guidance. The undies we collect will go into back-to-school bags for their children. A collection site will be in the Lewis Lobby as well as in the preschool suite.

**Elective Descriptions:** Please make sure you have indicated elective choices for all adults, youth, and gradeschoolers (rising 1st – 5th graders) on the adjacent page.

**Beginning Yoga** – Join us for gentle yoga postures and intentional breathing. All ages and levels welcome; no experience necessary. Led by Julie Rosier & Brenda Cleveland, certified yoga instructors.

**Wire Tree Sculptures** – Using beautiful gemstones and copper wire, come create a beautiful work of art! Led by DeLeon Turnage.

**Ceramics** – In this pottery-painting studio right in our church, we'll design and paint mugs, bowls, and plates which will ultimately make up place settings which will be given to Habitat families. There will be some additional bisques for younger artists who prefer to take their work home. Led by Margie Sasser & Leah Filomena.

**Creative Movement** – Join us as we discover creative ways to express ourselves through music and movement! No prior dance experience is necessary. Led by Crystal & Savannah Bacon.

**Upcycled Art** – Join us as we create a variety of unique arts and crafts! Try your hand at punch needle, "color" with yarn to make a coaster or wall hanging; paint & decorate a trinket box; construct creations out of recycled sheet music; make a wind chime out of recycled materials! Led by Jen Foster & Noel Tucker.

**Team Games** – Teamwork and cooperation is the name of the game in this active elective of tried and true and sometimes new group games! Led by Jeff Hobart & Holly Cook.

**Knit One, Purl Two** – Whether you're a pro or novice knitter, you have something to contribute to the FBC yarn as we create dishcloths to keep or to share as housewarming gifts for Habitat families. Best for older elementary ages on up. Led by Mary Powell Rhodes.

**Woodworking** – Build a bird house from the ground up and add this wonderful addition to any backyard! Participants have the option of offering their bird house as a housewarming gift to a new Habitat family. Led by Diane Ellis & Myra Brickell.

**Fun With Music** - Sing, Clap, Tap, and Snap your night with rhythmicizing joy to songs old and new, having fun with music! Led by Rhonda Lowe & Charlotte Phillips.

**Baffle-Painting Project!** -- Paint colorful designs or words of encouragement or blessing on large canvasses of cardboard which will become baffles in the next Habitat build! These baffles will be installed to help keep insulation in place – and we have the opportunity jazz them up with encouraging artwork! Led by Amy Galvan & Carol Blanchard.
